Scott Fried is a motivational speaker and author of three books for teens; *If I Grow Up: Talking to Teens About AIDS, Love and Staying Alive*; *My Invisible Kingdom: Letters from the Secret Lives of Teens*, and *A Private Midnight: A Teenager's Scrapbook of Secrets*. Through detailed personal accounts of teens from around the world, this talk reveals the secrets most teens would like to keep from their parents. Using himself as Exhibit A, Scott Fried shares the difficult story of his painful disclosures to his Conservative Jewish family. Additionally, this talk offers specific ideas and techniques on parenting a teenager through this difficult time of adolescent angst and their burgeoning experiences as the newest members of the sexual community.

This wonderful annual program is being made possible, in-part, by the Carly Vogel-Fischer Temple Israel Memorial Fund Lectureship, in memory of Carly. Carly's love of learning inspired her family to set up this fund, for the purpose of inspiring other teens at Temple Israel. Judaism and Temple Israel were integral parts of Carly's life. She celebrated many milestones at Temple and took great pride and pleasure in all of these events. She died in 1995 of an acute asthma attack, just four days after her Confirmation at Temple Israel.
